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5440 HONORING STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The Board values excellence and wishes to inculcate in pupils the desire encourage students to do their best in all things. It shall be the policy of this Board, therefore, to recognize outstanding academic accomplishment.

At the end of each school year, the secondary school graduates with the highest and second highest academic averages will be appropriately recognized. The academic average will be calculated based on grades through the end of the 3rd marking period. The Building Principal and appropriate staff shall determine the recipient of each award according to criteria previously established and approved by the Superintendent.

At the end of each marking period, those high school pupils who achieve an average of 3.0 shall be named to the Honor Roll. Those pupils who achieve an average of 3.5 shall be named to the High Honor Roll. Those pupils who achieve an average of 4.0 or better shall be named to the Principal's Honor Roll. A grade of D, F or I will hold a pupil off the Honor Rolls.

At the end of each marking period for the 4th 6th through 8th grades, a High Honor Roll and a Honor Roll shall be established. At the grade four through six level, High Honor Roll is attained with the A's in all graded subjects and Honor Roll status with any combination of A's and/or B's in all graded subjects.

Academic, athletic and other outstanding achievements shall be appropriately recognized during the school year by the principals and staff.
